

Tshepo Moloi is a senior lecturer in the Department of History at the University of Johannesburg. He obtained his MA and PhD in History from the University of the Witwatersrand. Moloi is the co-editor of *Guerrilla Radios in Southern Africa: Broadcasters, Technology, Propaganda Wars, and the Armed Struggle* and the sole author of *Place of Thorns: Black Political Protest in Kroonstad Since 1976*. He has also contributed chapters in the various volumes of *The Road to Democracy in South Africa* under the auspices of the South African Democracy Education Trust (SADET). Moloi is the editor of *New Contree Journal* and president of the Southern African History Society. He is the former president of the Oral History Association of South Africa (OHASA).
